Abstract

This collection is the personal scrapbook of Kathryn Heily depicting her trip to the Hawaiian Islands in 1921. It includes pictures, postcards, maps of the area and ephemera.

The material was removed from the original scrapbook and arranged in 9 folders.

The collection was inherited by Ms. Heily's great niece, Kathryn Ann Heily, and later donated to the Kauai Historical Society. The younger Ms. Heily has little recollection of her great Aunt's travels, and does not recall any details.

Scope

The collection begins on a cruise ship, which landed Feb. 9, 1921 in Honolulu. The original order has been maintained. All four major islands were visited: Oahu, Kauai, Maui and Hawaii. Besides the local maps, there is a map of the island chain provided by the Hawaii Tourism Bureau.

Ephemera includes a dinner menu from the Matson Line, along with some daily news bulletins from the steamship. There are travel brochures from the Matson Company as well. Additionally, several pages of poetry are in the final folder of the collection.

Pictures include photographs and postcards. Scenery is dominant, however, there are images of buildings, Jack London and his wife, Duke Kahanamoku, a postcard of Japanese women by photographer Jerome Baker, and sugar cane industry photographs.
